The administrator/supervisor acknowledges service centers belong to the public and they must provide educational opportunities to all. An administrator's/supervisor's actions will be viewed and appraised by the community, professional associates, and students. Therefore, the administrator/supervisor subscribes to the following standards:

The administrator/supervisor:

 Makes the well-being of students/staff/learning centers the basis for decision making and action;

• Fulfills professional responsibilities with honesty and integrity;

• Supports the principle of due process as required by law;

• Obeys local, state and national laws;

• Implements all board policies, rules and regulations;

• Pursues appropriate measures to correct those laws, policies and

regulations that are not consistent with sound educational goals;

• Avoids using an administrative/supervisory position for personal gain;

· Accepts academic degrees or professional certificates only from duly

accredited institutions;

• Seeks to improve the profession through research and continuing

professional development; and

• Honors employment contracts until fulfillment or release.
